Summary of Duties

- Provide direct supports, family centered counselling's, justice and prevention supports, and community capacity building.
- Promote awareness and ensure access to the program through a variety of outreach efforts with external committees.
- Conduct peers counselling, one to one or in a group setting.
- Refer children and youth to appropriate services as required to document, advocate and liase with internal and external resources.
- Respond to client emergencies and provide crisis intervention.
- Build networks with other agencies and refer clients when needed.

- Must have a Criminal Reference check, including Vulnerable Sector Screening completed and approved prior to commencement of employment.

- Experience in planning, coordinating, implementing and monitoring community-based programs.
