- Post-Secondary Degree or Diploma in Indigenous Studies and/or combination of equivalent and relevant educational experience.
- Must have a Criminal Reference check, including Vulnerable Sector Screening completed and approved prior to commencement of employment.
- Knowledge and experience working with the justice system.
- Working knowledge of counseling methods and case management practices.
- Strong knowledge and awareness of Indigenous culture and history, with particular emphasis on family violence, child welfare and the impacts of trauma.
